- We must ensure that all employees understand our environmental policy and conform to the high standards it requires.






Lottery prizes

Poznan



Eco-design display for L'Oréal France

As part of our long collaboration with I'Oréal professional products, We have added one more display to the sales tool catalogue. Under the impetus of L'ORÉAL's "Solidarity Sourcing Program", we have sought to significantly improve the eco-design of this POS display unit. To this aim, we have reviewed the entire product: its design, its materials, the partners involved and the production processes.



Product highlights:

- The base is made of recyclable ABS by a company in France,
- The entire acrylic is made of GREENCAST sheets which is a 100% recycled and recyclable plastic.
- The visuals are printed by a local company affiliated to the IMPRIM' VERT label.

Production:

 We've streamlined the number of partners and have selected the closest partners to shorten the supply chain.



- Adapted the workstations, created molds to facilitate the different operations.
- In total, more than 15 beneficiaries helped us for a total of more than 1800 hours between November 18 and May 2020.

Since its launch, this display has been a growing success, with more than 12,000 units delivered in 6 months.
